estate not already Bequeathed But in case there cannot be a Sufficiency raised from the
Sale of my Personal Estate to pay my Debts I Desire in that event and rather than
sell any of my Negroes that Fifty Acres of the Tract of Land lately purchased
of Alexander Colley and that part of it joining the Lands of William Nicholas
may be sold to the best Advantage & the Money arising from such Sale to be applied
towards the payment of all my Just Debts.

Item I give & bequeath to my loving Wife Elizabeth Talbot Two Negroes ~~or~~ One
Man Named Robin & one Negro Woman Named Betty during her life and after
her Death I give the said Slaves to my son Kedar Talbot.

Item, I give and Bequeath unto my son Kedar Talbot Two Negroes To wit one ne-
gro Man Named Loney and one Negro Boy Named Baker to him & his heirs for
ever. I give and Bequeath

After the death of one Negro Woman Named Betty during her life and after
her Death I give the said Slaves to my son Richard Talbot — — —
