=hood and at her death to be sold the moveable Estate and to be
equally divided amongst all my Children

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Bartlet Brown my land
with the houses & orchards thereon and if he should die with-
=out heirs of his body to fall to his brother Nathan Brown
but if he should die with

out him of his body to fall to his brother Nathan Brown
but if both should die the same to be equally divided amongst
the surviving children I also give my son Bartlet Brown one
horse the choice of my horses to him & his heirs also one of my
guns the choice of them and the other one I give to my son
Nathan Brown to them & their heirs also my boat I give to Bartlet
I appoint constitute & ordain my beloved wife Pembroke Brown and
my son Bartlet Brown the sole Executors of this my last will and
testament all & singular my lands meadows & tenements by them
freely to be possessed & enjoyed & I do hereby utterly depelore revoke
& disannul all & every other former testament with bequests bequests
& executors by one in any wife before named willed & bequeathed satisfying
& confirming this my last will & testament In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & seal this seventeenth day of Oct.
