that my Brethren, Cousins, or any other relation or person what-
soever shall have no part of my Estate real or personal. But my
express Will and Desire is, that my beloved wife Mary Gile shall have
all and every part of my Estate both real and personal to her and to
her heirs forever. Therefore I do request the worshipful the Justices
of the peace and Judge of the Court of Norfolk that they shall not use
my said wife wronged nor deprived of any thing that belongs to
her at my Death. I having given and do hereby give to her & to her
heirs for ever the whole and every part of my Estate of what kind
soever Signed, Sealed and delivered being my last Will and
Testament, this Twelfth day of March in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and forty one. And I do hereby

express Will and Desire, that my beloved wife Mary Giler shall have
all and every part of my Estate both real and personal to her and to
her heirs forever, Therefore I do request the worshipfull the Justices
of the peace and Judge of the Court of Norfolk, that they shall not use
my said wife wronged nor deprived of any thing that belongs to
me at my Death, I having given and do hereby give to her & to her
heirs for ever, the whole and every part of my Estate of what kind
soever, signed, sealed and delivered being my last Will and
Testament, this Twelfth day of March in the year of our Lord and
King and seven hundred and forty one. And I do appoint my said
Loving Wife to be Executrix of this my last Will & Testament
