In the following form and manner

I Am I Do Give and bequeath unto my loving wife, Mary Granberry my
Plantation, whereon I now live During her widowhood Likewise my
Negro Boy Dick During of her widowhood Likewise my plantation -
at the head of the Branch Called Boymoor's Neck for sixteen years
whereby meaning and Intending for my Children to be brought
up and to be taught and instructed in Learning as far as is needfull

I Am I Do Give and Bequeath the Rest and Residue of my Estate,
Unto my Loving Wife Mary Granberry and to my three Children
George Moses & Sarah to be Equally Divided Betwixt them, all,
Except one Large Pine Chest and one Small Trunk I Do Give unto
my Daughter Sarah Granberry and for my Children to Receive
to their Equall parts when they come to there proper age

I Am I Do Give and Bequeath unto my son George Granberry my land
and plantation, whereon I now live with all its primises there to
him and to heirs for Ever Likewise I Do Give and bequeath
unto my son George Granberry my Negro Boy named Dick to him
And to his heirs for Ever

I Am I Do Give and Bequeath unto my son Moses Granberry the
plantation at the head of the Branch Called Boymoor's Neck
With all its Primises thereunto after the term of sixteen
years are Expiered to him and his heirs for Ever

Further more I Do nominate constitute and appoint my lov-
ing Wife Mary Granberry and Thomas manning to be whole and
Sole my Executors further more I Do Revoke, frustrate, and
Renounce all other wills here to fore made By me and Do
allow this to be my Last Will and Testament
