

In the Name of God Amen. I James Jolliffe of the County of Norfolk being in a low state of health but of perfect sense and memory do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows

Imprimis The land and plantation whereon I now live including the land I purchased of William Smith and Richard Tomlinson, as also Taylors Island, I give and bequeath to my Sons William and James and their Heirs for ever to be equally divided between them, the division line to begin at the swamp side a Chingispin tree near the Spring, thence running about a West North West course so as to pass to the northward about fifteen feet of the young Apple Orchard, thence past the same and a few yards past the barn so as to divide the said Apple Orchard from the barn, thence about a North west course so as to make an equal division of the said plantation & lands between my said Sons William & James. It is my will and desire that my Son William have the North part and my Son James the South part of the said plantation and lands, and if either of my said Sons William & James should die without Heir that then I give the aforementioned land & plantation to the Survivor and his Heirs for ever.

Item. I give and bequeath to my said Sons William & James and their Heirs for ever Eighty seven Acres of Loppes swamp adjoining the land & plantation whereon I now live, to be equally divided between my said Sons William & James.

Item. I give and bequeath to my said Son William and his Heirs for ever one Negro Boy named Dennis.

Witness my hand this 1st day of March 1711 at Taylors Island Richard and Josiah and

as follows

Imprimis The land and plantation whereon I now live including the land I purchased of William Smith and Richard Tompman, as also Taylors Island, I give and bequeath to my Sons William and James and their Heirs for ever to be equally divided between them, the division line to begin at the swamp side a Chinquapin tree near the Spring, thence running about a West North West course so as to pass to the northward about fifteen feet of the young Apple Orchard, thence past the same and a few yards past the barn so as to divide the said Apple Orchard from the barn, thence about a North west course so as to make an equal division of the said plantation & lands between my said Sons William & James. It is my Will and desire that my Son William have the North part and my Son James the South part of the said plantation and lands, and if either of my said Sons William & James should die without Heir that then I give the aforementioned land & plantation to the survivor and his Heirs for ever.

Item. I give and bequeath to my said Sons William & James and their Heirs for ever Eighty seven Acres of Loppes Swamp adjoining the land & plantation whereon I now live, to be equally divided between my said Sons William & James.

Item. I give and bequeath to my said Son William and his Heirs for ever one Negro Boy named Dennis.

Item. I give and bequeath to my Sons Richard and Josiah and their Heirs for ever my land & Loppes Swamp at Ireland to be equally divided between them, but it is my Will and desire that if either of my said Sons Richard & Josiah should die without Heir then I give the said land & Loppes Swamp

swamp to the Survivor and his Heirs for ever

Item. It is my Will and desire that my Negro Wench Amy be at full Liberty to live where she pleases, and to enjoy all the Privileges of a free person, and not to be compelled to labour only for herself, for the faithful service she has heretofore done me

Item. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary and her Heirs for ever One Negro Boy named Charles

Item. I give and bequeath to my Daughters Mary and Elizabeth and their Heirs for ever all the Remainder of my Negroes to be equally divided between them

Item. All the remainder of my Estate I leave to be sold and after paying my just debts, it is ^{my} will and desire that the balance should be equally divided amongst all my Children to wit William, James, Richard, Josiah Mary and Elizabeth

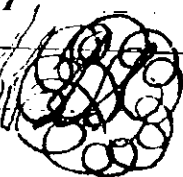
Lastly I nominate and appoint James Webb to be sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills made by me. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this Twenty seventh day of February in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & Ninety
