In the Name of God Amen. I James
Joloff of Portsmouth Parrish in Norfolk County being in
my perfect sense and sound memory, Thanks be to Almighty
God for the same, I do make and Ordain this to be my last
Will & Testament in manner & form as followeth, First I com-
mend my Soul unto the Almighty God that gave it me & my
Body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like and decent
manner at the discretion of my Exec^{rs} and as touching such
My Goods as it has been pleased the Almighty God to bless

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I give with I give & bestow in the manner and form as followeth, Viz.
I give unto my beloved Wife Sarah Jolloff the use & service
of my Negre Woman called Pegg during her widowhood only
and one third part of all the Remainder part of my whole Es-
tate of all kinds during her Widowhood only, and in case she
should marry I then give her only a Child's part of what has

2dly I give unto my Son Richard Jolloff, my Land & Plantation
whereon I now dwell to him & to the Male Heirs Law-
fully begotten of his own Body forever, and upon de-
fault of such Heirs I give the afore said Land unto my
Son James Jolloff & to the Male Heirs Lawfully be-
gotten of his own for ever.

3dly I give unto my Son James Jolloff my Land & Plan-
tation whereon he now dwells to him & to the Male
Heirs lawfully begotten of his own Body forever,
and upon Default of such Heirs I give the afore d. Land
unto my Son Richard Jolloff and to the Male Heirs
lawfully begotten of his own Body.

and upon Default of such Heirs I give the aforesaid Land
unto my Son Richard Joloff, and to the Male Heirs lawfully
begotten of his own Body forever.

4thly It is my Will my Two Negro Woman called Bier and Har-
nah shall be hired out to y^e best advantage Yearly un-
til my youngest Child arrives to the Age of Twenty one
years, & then the two Negros to be equally divided a-
mong Seven of my Children, viz^t. Elizabeth Joloff,
George Joloff, James Joloff, Joyce Joloff, Migail
Joloff, Sarah Joloff, & Selah Joloff, It is my Will
also that my Negro called Pegg after the expiration
of my Wifes Widowhood be equally divided among my
Seven Children aforesaid in the same manner as
the other Two Negroes before given them.

5thly I give all the Remaining part of my Estate that is not already
mentioned, after all my just Debts be paid unto my Seven
Children that is before mentioned by Name to be equally
divided among them, hereby revoking & making void all

other Wills & Testaments by me heretofore made.
lastly I appoint my Two Sons George Jolliff and James Jolliff, to be the
whole & Sole Execs. to this my last Will and Testament.
Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my Hand and affixed my Seal
this the 18th Day of November in the Year of our Lord 1775.
