my last Will and Testament My desire is that my Mother should

And please God I had lived then I give and bequeath to my
dearly beloved Sister Rachael Keach the Melbourn Woman Vines
and Children And Thirty five pounds Money And all the
rest of my personal Estate to be delivered at the time of my death
to the said Rachael Keach and her Children

Keep my Money till the time of my death
And I leave God I had Lived I then I Give and bequeath to my
dearly beloved Sister Rachael Reads the Melattor Woman Vines
and Children And Thirty five pounds Money And all the
rest of my personal Estate to be delivered at the time of my death

of us In the Year of our Lord God November 7th 1742
