to my Son William Millifor as before mentioned, the said
Land always to remain possessed by the Male heir or heirs
bearing the Name of Millifor - - - - -

Millifor all and Every Part of my Personal
Estate wherewith I am or may be possessed to
have & to hold the same to her own proprie^ty
and Benefit to hold & possess the same all the
time she continues a widow, and in case of her
Marriage or Death, she to receive the Benefit &
Value of the third part of my Personal Estate to be
at her own Disposal & Will, the Other part to be
Equally Divided among my three youngest
