and Memory, do make and Ordain this to be my
Last Will and Testament
I Lend the use of The Land, and Plantation where
on I now live, also The Gum Swamp Land, To my
Loving Wife Sarah Webb during her Natural life
I also lend my said Wife, Five Negroes (Five) Two negro
Men, Two Negro Women, and One Negro Boy; Her
Choice of all I have, and Two Horses Her Choice
also The Double Chair with all my Household
and Kitchen Furniture, during Her Natural life
and after her decease, To be disposed of as here after
mentioned
I Give and Bequeath unto my son James Webb
all my lands on the West side the Poplar neck Road
Including the Land given to me by Patrick Mackey
except One Hundred Acres, lying on Charles
Terrell's line, and the Swamp; also I Give my said
Son James Webb, The One half of my lands known
by the Name of Ireland. To him and his Heirs for Ever
I Give and bequeath, unto my son John Corprew, The
Plantation where on I now live, and the Gum Swamp
Land; after the Decease of my said wife; and I also
give my said Son John Corprew the One half of

Last Will and Testament
I lend the use of the Land, and Plantation where
on I now live, also the Gum Swamp Land, To my
Loving Wife Sarah Webb, during her Natural life
I also lend my said Wife, Five Negroes (Viz) Two negro
Men, Two Negro Women, and One Negro Boy; Her
Choice of all I have, and Two Horses Her Choice
also the Double Chair with all my Household
and Kitchen Furniture, during her Natural life
and after her decease, to be disposed of as hereafter
mentioned

I Give and Bequeath unto my Son James Keeler
all my lands on the West side the Poplar neck Road
Including the Land Given to me by Patrick Mackey,
except One Hundred Acres, binding on Charles
Terabee's line, and the Swamp; also I Give my said
Son James Keeler, The One half of my lands known
by the Name of Ireland, To him and his Heirs for ever

I Give and bequeath, unto my Son John Corprew, The
Plantation where on I now live, and the Gum Swamp
Land; after the Decease of my said wife; and also
give my said Son John Corprew, The One Hundred Acres
of Land taken from the Land, on the West side the
Poplar neck Road; and binding on the line of
Charles Terabee, and the Swamp as before said

also the other half of my land known by the Name of
Ireland. To him and his Heirs for Ever but in case
That either of my said Sons should die without lawful
Issue; or before they arrive to the Age of twenty one
years. Then it is my will and desire That The
Survivor possess and enjoy the whole of These Lands
and Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah
One Negro Girl her First Choice To her and her
Heirs for Ever

I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Penelope
One Negro Girl her Second Choice To her and
her Heirs for Ever

I Give and bequeath all The Rest of my Estate not
before disposed of To be equally divided amongst
my Four Children ~~the~~ Sarah, Penelope, James Kedar
and John Carpenter, part and part alike To them
and their Heirs for Ever

I also Give and bequeath The Negroes and personal Estate
which I have lent to my wife Sarah after her Death
To be equally divided amongst my Four said Children
Sarah, Penelope, James Kedar and John Carpenter
part and part alike To them and their Heirs for Ever

I do Nominate my Loving Sarah Webb an Executrix
and my Friend Kedar Webb an Executor To This my
Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I
have here unto set my hand and Seal This Fourth
Day of July One Thousand Seven Hundred
and Ninety Two

I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah
One Negro Girl, her First Choice To her and her
Heirs for Ever

I Give and bequeath, unto my Daughter Penelope
One Negro Girl, her Second Choice To her and
her Heirs for Ever

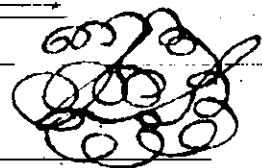
I Give and bequeath all The Rest of my Estate not

At a Court held for Norfolk the 17th day of September 1792.

This last Will and Testament of James Webb deceased was this day

 there to and ordered to be recorded Sarah Webb and Mordar Webb executors
 therein named having taken the Oath and given bond and security
 according to Law Certificate for obtaining a probat was granted
