Item I Give and Bequeath to my Grandson Nicholas Mack one Negro Girl called Bridget and her Increase to him and the Heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten and if the said Nicholas Mack dies without Heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten then the said Negro Bridget and her then living Increase to be equally divided amongst all my living children. I likewise give and Bequeath to my Grandson Nicholas Mack one Bed and Furniture to him and his Heirs for ever.

Item My Will and desire is that my Loving Wife Elizabeth Withins shall keep in possession and enjoy the Labour and Use of all my Negroes before given (except those ^{the} Legatees are now possess'd off) during her

Heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten and if the said William Prescott dies without heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten then the said Negro Turkey and her ^{then} living Increase to be Equally amongst all my living Children

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Grandson Nicholas Mack one Negro Girl called Bridget and her Increase to him and the Heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten and if the said Nicholas Mack dies without Heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten then the said Negro Bridget and her then living Increase to be equally divided amongst all my living Children I likewise give and Bequeath to my Grandson Nicholas Mack one Bed and Furniture to him and his Heirs for ever

Item My Will and desire is that my Loving Wife Elizabeth Withins shall keep in possession and enjoy the Labour and Use of all my Negroes before given (except those ^{the} Legatees are now proposed off) during her Natural life and after her Decease each Legatee before mentioned then to take in possession the Legacies so before given

Item I Give unto my Son James Withins seven pounds Virginia Currency
to be delivered him at my Death.

Item I Give to my Son William Withins Fifteen pounds Virginia Currency
to be delivered him at my Death.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Loving Wife Elizabeth Withins all the
remainders of my Estate not before Given as Household Goods Stock
Cash Debts &c. during her Natural Life and after her decease to be
Equally divided amongst my then living Children.

And I Appoint and Nominate my Wife Elizabeth Withins
Executrix and my Son James Withins and my Son Joshua Withins
