whatsoever, it hath pleased God to bestow on me, I give and Bequeath in manner & form following
Item My will is I give and Bequeath unto my loving Husband, John Lindsay, my part of a Tenement
of Land, given to me by my father John Boyd Sailor in Crawfords Dyke, aforesaid, with all my Rights
Tittle and Interest thereunto, as also I give and Bequeath unto my said Loving Husband John
Lindsay, my full share of all Legacies, to me left, by any person or persons whatsoever in
Great Britain or Ireland, and all my Estate Real as well as personal, to him his heirs, Executors,
administrators, and assigns, forever, and I hereby Appoint my foresaid loving Husband, John Lindsay
to be Executor of this my last will and Testament. Herby Revoking all Disposing, all my former
Testaments, by me heretofore made, and Declaring this to be my last will and Testament.
