Jenny If ever the said Mare should Bring any Fole be it Horn

I hereby Give and the said Mare should Bring any Fole or more
or more that is seen to suck her I Give it to him my Son Jare^t &
One Huffer Yearling that lives to be 2 year old, The said before
mentioned to my Son Jeremiah & the said I Give to him & his heirs
forever —

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Thomas & the said
two two year old Yearlings If the same lives to bring them
and raise them to such an age —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Loving Wife all the Re-
= maining part of my Estate that I have not mentioned I Give
unto my Loving Wife to bring my Children up and to keep my
riding Saddle I leave to my Children to ride about upon their
Business On —

Item I do make my Loving Wife my Executor of all my Estate
before mentioned During ^{her} Widowhood Jan^y the 14th day 1763.
