Wherein my son Jonah now lives Shall be included in his part The
House wherein my son Jese now lives as also the House wherein I Live
Shall be included in my said son Jese's Part ~ My son Caleb's part will
have no House on it ~ Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter
Mary, a Negro Wench Named Judy also a Negro Girl Named Sukey together
with their future Increase I give the same to my said Daughter Mary and
her Heirs for ever, Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Uphan One
Negro girl Named Dinah together with her future Increase also a Negro Boy
Named Phillips, I also give To my Said Daughters Uphan One Feather Bed and
Furniture also Money Sufficient to Buy her a Decent Suit of Cloaths I also give
To my Said Daughter Uphan (after The Decease of her Mother, One Old Negro

shall be included in my said Son Jeph's Part - My Son Caleb's part will
have no House on it. Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter
Mary, a Negro Wench Named Judy also a Negro girl Named Sukey together
with their future Increase I give the same to my said Daughter Mary and
her Heirs for ever. Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Uphan One
Negro girl Named Dinah together with her future Increase also a Negro Boy
Named Philip. I also give to my said Daughter Uphan One Feather Bed and
Furniture also Money Sufficient to Buy her a Decent Suit of Cloaths I also give
to my said Daughter Uphan (after the Decease of her Mother, One Old Negro
Wench Named Grace all and every of the above I give to my said Daughter
Uphan & her Heirs for ever I give and Bequeath to my Son Caleb One
Negro Boy Named Jack also a Negro Boy Named ^{one} Lewis and ^{one} Feather Bed
and Furniture I give the same to my Son Caleb & his Heirs for ever
Item I leave to my Loving Wife During her Natural Life after my debts are
Paid all The Remainder of my Estate of what Kind so ever and after
the Decease of my said Wife I give and Bequeath the same Negroes
excepted to be equally Divided amongst my sons Jeph and Caleb in

Then Henceforward. Lastly I nominate and appoint my Loving Wife Mary
Crenton and my sons Joshua and Jesse to be Executors of this my Last Will and
Testament. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the
