perfectly sound in Mind, but sorely afflicted in body do
Make this my last Will, & Testament in manner and form ^(Saying)
In witness. I give and bequeath unto my son James his heirs,
& assigns for ever, one Negro Boy named Bristol.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my son William his heirs &
assigns, for ever one Negro Girl named Jenny.

Item. I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas, his heirs & assigns
For Ever one Negro boy named Culley.

Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughten Elizabeth one
Negro Girl named Celia, to her heirs & assigns for ever.

In the same Manner as To my sons James William & Thomas

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I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Annis her heirs &
Assigns for ever one Negro boy named Jacob. It is my Will
& Intention that Ned of Rose be Annually hired out, &
The hire Applied to the purpose of Educating my Sons James
William & Thomas; untill they arrive at the Age of Twenty
Years, then the said Ned of Rose with all Fories children, not
Already given away to be Equally divided between my
said Sons James William & Thomas. Thereby direct
The Executors of this my last Will & Testament, to send
Into N. Carolina, & sail upon nine months credit, Three
Horses two of them sorrels, & one Bay, with Two Saddles &
Three bridles the money arising from the sale of the
Horses to be appropriated together with sundry other
Lawfull debts & Obligations due me, to be hereafter Enu-
merated, to the purpose of paying my lawfull debts, and
The balance to be Equally divided among my Sons James
William & Thomas

Laifull debts & Obligations due me, to be here after con-
-mated to the purpose of paying my laifull debts and
The balance to be Equally divided among my sons James
William & Thomas.

I give unto my beloved Wife Sarah, for ever one Mare
Likewise all my Household & Kitchen Furniture during
Her widowhood, & at her death to be Equally divided Am-
-ong all my children In case my said Wife Sarah should
Marry, all the aforesaid furniture her heirs only Excepted to
be sold & divided as above.

The debts for which I leave no obligations are as follows Viz
William Dancer £6 20,000 York Thomas Watchdon 1900
£6 York Mr. Watchdon 1000 £ Exclusive of his Obligations.

These debts together with what remains of all my Laifull
Debts & Obligations after discharging those due by me, to be
Divided as already mentioned.

Shirley appoint William Batchelor of Edgecombe County
North Carolina, Jui Brown, & Emanuel Latchwell, both
of Portsmouth parish & Norfolk colly Virginia, to be Exec-
utors of this my last Will & Testament, revoking & annulling
any will or Testament made previous to this In Witness
Whereof I have set my Name & Seal this 10th Day of March 1782
