Walnut desk to him and his Heirs for ever.

Item I give to my Daughter Ann Herbert one negro Boy named
Merica at my decease one Negro Women sue one Negro Boy
Named Lues and one Negro Boy named Rofi and one
plantation in Norfolk County by Estimation sixty six
Acres be the same more or less and one Mill at her
Mothors decease to her and her heirs for ever.

Item I give to my well Beloved wife Mary all the remaining
part of my estate within and without during her life after
my debts is paid and after her decease to be Equally divided be-
tween my Two Children Anne Martee and Ann Herbert.

Lastly I nominate and appoint my Wife Mary and my Son

 and Testament and do hereby disallow revoke and make
 Void all and every former Will by me in way before this
