my Lands that I am now possessed with after the Death of
my Lawful wife Jane Carney and if she should die before he
comes to age the said Land to be rented out yearly and the
Money to be kept for him the said William Carney. I leave
all the rest of my Worldly Goods and Estates to Equally divide
between my Lawful Wife Jane Carney and Sarah Carney &
William Carney and the rest of my Brothers & Children I nominate
and Appoint my Loving Wife and Richard Carney to be my
