Almighty God, my Creature hoping for the Remission Pardon
of manifold Sins and Wickedness through the Merits of Blessed Re-
deemer, the Lord Jesus Christ, And my Body to the Earth to be
buried in a Christian like manner And after my Just Debts
and funeral Charges are paid then I Give my said Worldly Goods
as follows

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son James Gally One
Young Cow to him and his Heirs forever

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son William Gally, One Young
Cow to him and his Heirs forever

Attest my Hand and Seal this 10th day of June 1734

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son Sam^l Colley One Young
Cow to him and his Heirs forever —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son Nath^l Colley One Young
Cow to him and his Heirs forever —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son John Colley One Negro
Tallow Pater, One Whip saw One Hand Mill, One Large Iron pot
and half dozen Painter plates and he to pay all Debts And also
I Give one Young Steer to my Grand Daughter Abigail Simmons
at the day of Marriage to her and her Heirs forever —

And all the Rest of a Estate not before Given away I Give unto
~~all my Son, to be Equal to be Divided amongst them after my death~~
to them and their Heirs forever And I do Order and Appoint my
Son John Colley to be my whole and Sole Executor of this to be my
Last Will and Testament Revoked all former Wills made by me
Validating and confirming of this to be my Last Will & Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this Twenty
Eighth of October One thousand Seven Hundred & Fifty two —
