together with my Lot of Land lying in the Borough of Ne-  
-folk which is my Will and Desire that my said Wife  
Sarah Dunn shall have and enjoy every part and parcel  
during her Life, and then my Will is that my Estate  
shall be sold to the best advantage and the Money to  
be equally divided between my children Elizabeth Th<sup>o</sup>mas  
Mary Dunn Sarah Dunn, James Dunn, Anne Dunn and John  
Dunn Excepting my Gun & Silver Shoe Buckles which  
I give to my son James and my Silver Watch I give to my son  
John. And my Desire is that my Wife may if she thinks proper  
sell the above Negro James and dispose of the Money arising  
as she thinks best and my Will and desire is that my Wife  
Sarah be my Exec<sup>r</sup> and my trusty friends Scarbrough Jan-  
-nard and Samuel Tomlinson my Exec<sup>r</sup> of this my last Will and
