

In the Name of Almighty God. Amen. I John Ellegood of Norfolk Borough, being at this present Time, in my ordinary health Memory and understanding, do make my last Will and Testament in manner following —

I empower and absolutely authorize my Executor hereafter mentioned to sell, convey and dispose of as much of my Lands, Lots & Houses in Norfolk Borough and County, as shall be sufficient to pay all my just and lawfull Debts, and likewise to raise the sum of six hundred pounds to be equally divided betwixt my two Sisters, Rebecca the Wife of Wilson Newton and Fernelia Ellegood, but to the fulfilling the above purposes, my Will is that my Executor shall sell & make use of all my personal Estate first, before any of my said Lands, Houses &c shall be sold —

I give unto my Mother and Sister Alice Smith five pounds each of them, to buy Rings with, all other remainders & Reversions of whatever Estate real or personal, that I am now possessed of I

of them, to buy Rings with, all other remainders & Reversions
of what ever Estate real or personal, that I am now possessed of, I
give and bequeath unto my beloved Brother Jacob Ellegood and
to his heirs forever. I constitute and appoint Charles Smith of
Cliza River Parish Minister the sole Executor of this my last
Will, revoking and disannulling all other Wills and Testaments
whatsoever. Witness my hand & Seal the 17 day of March A.D. 1757.
