do make this my last Will & Testament. Imprimis I give to my son William Ellegood
the Lott of Land where James Giles now liveth which I bought of Thomas & George Mason
with all the Houses thereon to him & y^e heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever & likewise
that Plantation I purchased of Thomas & Mary Mason formerly belonging to Mayer
Newton to him & y^e heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever containing abt. Two
two hundred Acres. I likewise give to my son William Ellegood a negro Woman named with all
her future Increase. Item I give to my Wellbeloved Wife the house & Lott where now I live with
all y^e out houses & conveniences thereon which I bought of Capt. Solomon Wilson during the
term of her naturall life & also that Plantation called Jones Point which I bought of Thomas
and George Mason during her naturall life together with y^e benefit of all stock thereon
leaving y^e Principal good at last & after her decease I give the sd. Lands above sd. in town &
County to my son John Ellegood to him & y^e heirs of his body lawfully begotten forever
Item I give to my well beloved Wife for ever & y^e heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever
Prochmain to her & her heirs forever I give to my well beloved Wife all my household
goods except my silver Trenchard to my son John & my great looking glass to my son William
after her decease. It is y^e express of my Will that my Wife shall have & enjoy the above given
In full of her dower of all my Lands. Item I give to my son John Ellegood two Negroes
Sheba & Baistob & their Increase. Item I give to my son Mason Ellegood y^e Lott of Land with
all appurtenances & houses whereon Thos. Walker now liveth & all y^e piece of Land opposite
thereto which I bought of Rich. Davis & Grace his Wife to him & y^e heirs of his body lawfully
begotten forever & likewise my Negro Wench Hannah & y^e Increase. Item I give to my son

after her decease. It is my express will that my Wife shall have & shall have above given
In full of her dower of all my Lands. I give to my son John Ullgood two Negroes
Shabaz Baistob & their increase. Item I give
all appurtenances & houses whereon I have
thereto which I bought of Rich Davis by Grace his Wife to him & the heirs of his body lawfully
begotten forever & likewise my Negro Wench Hannah & her increase I give to my son
Jacob Ullgood the two lots of land which I bought of Thomas Martin & Matthew Ullgood &
Margaret his Wife to him & the heirs of his body lawfully begotten forever & likewise my two
Negroes young London & Ben. Item I leave my Sea Steep & all other my Waters & whatsoever
to be sold immediately after my decease for money at a twelve months credit with security as also
all my sum & dry goods with all wares & Merchandises which I now have by me together with
some dry goods I expect from Whitehaven all to be sold for ready Money as my Executors shall
think most for my advantage of my Estate & that Money & what money I now have by me
after Paying my two daughters Rebekah & Fumelia Ullgood, three hundred Pounds apiece
Current Money of Virginia when they shall arrive at the age of twenty one years or more
the remainder to be equally divided between my Wife & four sons. Item I give to my daughter
Rebekah Ullgood two Negroes Jack & Jonny & to my daughter Fumelia Ullgood
their increase. Item I give to my son William Ullgood my negro Man Han
to my son Macon Ullgood & a Plantation in Little Creek co. I bought of Thoms
Margaret his Wife to him & the heirs of his body lawfully begotten forever
Man Will to be sold for money & the money I give to my son Jacob Ullgood &
Negro men Toney London & Ben to be sold for money as also my two Hays

Wife and four sons. And all the rest of my Estate of what nature or kind soever to be divided between my Wife & four sons. I constitute & appoint my loving Wife & brother Jacob Ellegood - and my trusty friends Capt. Edward Pugh & Capt. John Shing to be my executors of this my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 30th day of September 1720
