Item I give unto my Granddaughter Elizabeth Wright two Lacied silver spoons. Item I give
unto my Granddaughter Sarah Wright one small silver spoon. Item Lastly I give &
bequeath unto my loving Wife Elizabeth Harris all my Personal Estate goods chattels
moveables & immoveables wh^{soever} during her widowhood ^{standing} all y^e
rest & residue of ^{my} Personal estate goods & chattels ^{after} such is not already
given to my children I give & bequeath unto my loving Wife ^{during her natural}
Life. Furthermore I constitute & appoint my loving Wife ^{whole & sole executrix}
of y^e my last Will & Testament disannulling & making void all ^{my} will or wills
by me heretofore made In Witness whereof I have hereunto ^{my hand & seal y^e 10 day of}
March in y^e year of our lord 1736/
