Sens and Memory do make and ordain this my Last Will and
Testament in Manner and form as followeth —
1. I recommend my Soul to Almighty God that gave it and
my Body to the Earth to be decently buried —
 2. I give unto my Son John Hollowell my plantation, which
now dwells on, with all the Land belonging to it and the Water
Mill that lies on it, with the odd Mill stones in the house and
Iron Sledge, also I give him my large Bible, & Sermon, all
which Land Mill and other things I give unto my said Son John
Hollowell and his heirs for ever —
 3. I give unto my Son Thomas Hollowell the plantation which
I bought of my Cousin Tho: Hollowell with all the Land belong-
ing thereto containing one hundred and Ten Acres & also the Water
Mill that is on it and the Iron Crow and my whip Saw & cutting
knives and one good Silver Spoon and a Book the History of the
Quakers, all which Land Mill and other things herein men-
tioned I give unto my said Son Thomas Hollowell and
his heirs for ever —
 4. I give unto my Daughter Rachel Copeland and Silas

2 I give unto my son John Hollowell my
now dwell on with all the Land belonging to it and the Water
Mill the kiln on it, with the odd Mill stones in the house and
Iron Stodge, also I give him my large Bible, & Sermon, all
which Land Mill and other things I give unto my said son John
Hollowell and his heirs for ever —

3 I give unto my son Thamas Hollowell the plantation which
I bought of my Cousin Tho' Hollowell with all the Land belong-
ing thereunto, and hundred and Ten Acres & also the Water
Mill that is on it and the Iron beam and my whip saw & cutting
knives and one good Silver Spoon and a Book the History of the
Quakers, all which Land Mill and other things herein men-
tioned I give unto my said son Thamas Hollowell and
his heirs for ever —

4 I give unto my Daughter Rachael Copeland one Silver
Spoon, also I give unto my Daughter Mary Hollowell one Silver
Spoon, also I give unto my Daughter Sarah Hollowell one Silver
Spoon and one pair of Querns Mill stones —

5 I give unto my loving wife Sarah Hollowell the old Service
Hall

of all my Estates of what sort or kind soever, for her to support herself and family during her natural life

6 But my wife shall not sell, mortgage nor imbezzle any of the Estate that is here bound

7 After the expiration of my wife's life I then give all my Estates of what sort or kind soever and Stock of all sorts only what is already given away to be equally divided amongst all my Children that shall be then living, by three honest men such as my Children shall think proper to choose to appraise and divide my said Estate among them, viz: Nathaniel, Mary, Sarah, John and Thomas, but if any be dead before such division then only among them that are living, all which Negroes and other Estates that they shall enter in possession, such Estate as shall fall to their Share I give unto them and their heirs for ever

8 I order that my Estate be only surveyed and not appraised after proving this Will

9 In case my wife should die before my two sons John & Thomas be of age to take care of them I give to my Brother Tho: Hollaway the sum of 1000 £

8 I order that my Estate be only Invented & not appraised
after proving this Will

9 In case my wife should die before my two said John &
Thomas be of age to take care of them that said In my
Brother Tho: Hollowell shall take care of them & their Estates also

10 I make and ordain my loving wife Sarah Hollowell & my
two said John & Thomas Hollowell my whole sole ²⁰ & ²⁷ ~~20~~ & ~~27~~
of this my last Will and Testament making void all other
Wills and Testaments before made In Witness hereunto I
have set my hand and Seal this 24th day of the 1st Month 1751.
