and Memory do make and Ordain this my Last Will & Testament
in Manner and form as followeth To Wit

^{1st} I Recommend my Poor Soul to Almighty God who Goodness
and my Body to the Earth to be decently buried at the Direc-
tion of my Executors hereafter Named

^{2^{dy}} I Give unto my Son William Jay my House that is On the
South side of the Road with Liberty of a garden and privy
for one Year after my Decease I also Give unto my said Son
William One Negro man Named Luomineer unto him & his
Heirs I also Give unto my said Son William All my Out-
standing Debts Only five Pounds Excepted which are due to
me to Value of One Hundred and fifty Pounds, but more or
less, and also his choice of one of my Feather Beds and
Furniture

^{3^{dy}} I Give unto my Son John Jay all my Land unto him &
his Heirs forever, and all my Oxen & Hogsheads

^{4th} I Give unto my Loving Wife Sarah Jay my former dwelling

House which my Son John now Dwells in, & I have to keep it
in Repair for her during her Natural life

4th 5 I Give unto my Son Samuel Joy One Negro woman named
Maurd to him and his Heirs and also ^{one} Gun

4th 6 I Give unto my Son in Law Luke Slater five Shillings Cash
I also Give unto my Daughter Charity Slater the Blacking
I own & I Exempted, and for my Son William to buy Goods to
make up in Woman's Cloaths for her own Use

4th 7 I Will that all the rest of my personal Estate which
is not already given away be Equally Divided in to three
Parts One third I Give the Use and Service of unto my Loving
Wife Sarah Joy during her Natural life

4th 8 I Give the Other two Parts of my Estate so Divided One of
the Parts to my Daughter Rezinah Joy, and the Other Part to
my Daughter Patience Foreman

4th 9 after the Decease of my W^{ife} that Part of ^{which I}
lent to her I Give to be Equally Divided on ^{my two}
Daughters Rezinah and Patience

10. I desire my three Neighbours, Geo. William Rogers, Henry
Brink and John Hallensted to appraise and divide
my aforesaid Estate according to the true Intent & Meaning
of this my Will

11. I do make Appoint and constitute & Ordain my two Sons
John Jorg and William Jorg to be my Whole and Sole
Executors of this my Last Will and Testament hereunto
and making Void all other Wills and Testaments made
by me both Verbal and Written In Witness whereof I
have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this first Day of
November in the Year of our Lord 1749
