ing the Shortness and uncertainty of this Life, and that it is
appointed for all Men once to die, submitting myself to the Will
of God and the Merits and Merits of Jesus Christ do hereby pre-
pare and provide to settle my temporal Affairs in Time left I
should be deprived hereafter of such an Opportunity, and there-
fore if it should please God to call me hence by death before I have
sold and disposed of all my Store Goods, I desire that the follow-
ing Legacies & desires be strictly observed by my Executors, viz
Imp^t. That the Sum of Five hundred and eighty five pounds sixteen
shillings Sterling be paid out of my Estate, to satisfy and pay
off my Brother Alex^r Jameson of London, Taylor, for such Goods
as I had of him by Capt Crawford in April last, and that speedy
and just payment be made to him the said Alex^r Jameson

and just payment be made to him the said Alfred Jameson my
brother without loss of Time or Expences to him —

Item It is my Will and I hereby leave and bequeath to my loving
and discreet Wife Jemima Jameson if she survive me, all the
remainder of my Estate of whatever kind, whether Store Goods
Book Debts, or Household furniture, after the payment of
my Debts, and funeral Charges, to her the W^d Jemima Jameson forever.

Item I hereby nominate and appoint my said loving & lawfull
Wife Jemima Jameson the sole Executrix of this my Will and
Testament, revoking all other Will or Wills by me made, and de-
claring this to be my last Will and Testament at Norfolk
Borough in Virginia this th 30 day of May 1760 Years.
