one feather bed & rugg blank sheet blanket & bolster & my pistols & and y^e best all purpose & I
and one pair of iron wedges & one bow my Tack & drawing knife & hand saw. fourthly I give
unto my son Richard Jolley one Plantation wherby he now dwelleth on unto him & his
heirs forever also unto y^e s^r son Richard Jolley one feather bed & furniture already in his
house & my shot Gun & one pair of Iron Wedges & one bow & one bow & Pigeon to his liking
fifthly I give unto my son Peter Jolley one feather bed & rugg & blanket sheet & bolster & one
long gun one p^r of Iron Wedges. Sixthly I give unto my two sons John & Richard my two
Land containing one hundred acres more or less to be equally divided between them & to y^e
& their heirs forever & my son Peter to get one thousand Haves his share. Seventhly I give unto

up & to plant & ministerly I give unto my Daughter Mary Taylor my Negro Woman named
Sarah & to her & her heirs for and only of a Negro shall serve with my Wife Martha folley
two years after my decease & then go to my Daughter Mary Taylor & I give unto my
Daughter Sarah Rodes one Negro Girl named Pegg unto her & her heirs forever.
Item I give unto my Daughter Susannah Bowers my Negro Man named Will
unto her & her heirs forever only please if time use & service of a Negro Will unto
my Wife Martha folley during her Widowhood & after to go to my Daughter Susanna
Bowers. Twelfthly I give unto my Daughter Rachel folley one Negro Girl named Nanny unto
her & her heirs forever & one large covered Dinner Dish & one Dozen of English Spoons & one
new Dinner basin & one small Cast & one linnen wheel now this negro Nanny & a spinning
wheel is already in her custody. Thirteenthly I give unto my youngest Daughter Mary
Mary folley one Negro boy named Jacob & in case she should dye under age of this Negro
boy Jacob to go to her sister Ann folley. Fourteenthly I give unto my wife Martha folley one
Feather bed & furniture & three large Dinner Dishes & ten Dinner Plates & one Dozen of
Spoons & warming Pan & one trunk that was hers before Marriage to one & also one bed &
furniture that was of Hitchin & one Cow & calf & Stear all which goods & Chattels I give unto
my wife Martha & to Disposing & also one Iron Pot of four gallons. fifteenthly I give unto
my wife Martha folley my riding horse & one box. Sixteenthly I give my youngest daughter
Ann folley one silver aged about two years old. Seventeenthly I give unto my wife Martha

 by me to be equally divided among y^m three. Twentiethly I give unto my Wife Martha Jolley one
 woollen wheel & one linen wheel which wheels is now in her custody. 21st I give unto my Wife
 Martha Jolley all her Portion as is mentioned to her during her widowhood. & then to be divided
 between her two Daughters Mary Jolley & Ann Jolley as she shall see fit. 22nd I give unto my Grand
 daughter Lida Jolley one ewe Lamb. Item I give unto my Wife Martha & my son Richard Jolley
 all my flax & cotton to be equally divided between y^m my wife to have two shares & my son
 Richard one share. I do make constitute & ordain my two sons John Jolley & Richard Jolley to be my
 whole & sole Executors of my last Will & Testament make void all other wills & Testaments by me
 made herebefore in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal y^e 5th day of April in y^e
 year of our Lord 1706
