hereafter Named And as to the Remainder of my Estate after my Debts & Funeral
Expenses be paid and Satisfied I Give the whole both Real and Personal unto my
Present Wife Director the Daughter of Charles Dickerson until my son William
Born of her Body shall Attain to the Age of Twenty One Years my said Wife
Director do maintain and Educate him out of the profits of the said Estate so
long as he is under the Age of Twelve years Old to send him at her Expense to my
Brother Daniel McLachlan in Greenock, where she is still to Support him
Until he shall Arrive to the said Age of Twenty One Years, And my Will and
desire is that upon my son William the Son of the said Director Arrival to the
Age of Twenty One Years that then there be an Equal Division of my real
Estate both Real and Personal one half of which I Give to my said son
William Born of the Body of the said Director Dickerson to him & his Heirs for

being sent to Her and at Twelve years Old to send him
Brother Daniel McLachlan in Greenock, where she is still to support him.
Untill he shall arrive to the said age of Twenty One Year, And my Will and
desire is that upon my son William the son of the said Director arrival to
Age of Twenty One Year that then there be an Equal Division of my real
Estate both Real and Person One half of which I give to my said son
William Born of the Body of the said Director Dickerson to him & his Heirs for
And the other Half my wife to continue to have the use During her Natural
life and at her Death I give the same to my said son William & to his Heirs
for ever But my Desire is that if my son William should die before he
arrives to the Age of Twenty one year without Issue then I give the
hereby given to him unto John McLachlan the son of my Brother &
McLachlan and to his Heirs for ever
My Reasons for giving my Estate in the Manner before mentioned
my present wife is that eighteen years & upwards ago I married
a Woman in Scotland who stole from me and had stolen

277 which I do not know there they be living & dead But I do hereby Disclaim such one
and do give Him five Shillings Sterling in full for any claim he may have as
my ~~Heir~~ ^{Heir} of my Estate, and do Renounce any other wife that may present
Wife Director. Lastly I nominate Constitute and Appoint my Friends Abraham
Gibson and John Bannan my Executors and my Wife Director the Daughter of
Charles Dickerson Executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby Revoking
all former Wills before made and Declaring this only as and for the same
For Witnesses whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this fifth of Feb^r 1774
