Impressed I give and devise unto my son Robert and his Heirs
for ever The land on which he now lives on below the Great
Bridge. I also give unto my said son Robert one Negro boy
called Tom as also Ten pounds to be raised out of my ^{late} Estate

Item, I give and bequeath unto my son John one Negro named
Mingo. I also give unto my said son John the sum of Ten pounds Pound
Current Money nevertheless the said money is given him on Con-
-dition that he do not disturb nor molest my son Robert in the

Quiet Possession of the land on which my said son Robert ^(now lives)
Item. I give and devise unto my son William and his Heirs for
ever The Plantation on which I now live to a branch that

of the Common swamp along side the Plantation to

over The Plantation on which I now live to a branch that
runs out of the Cypress swamp along side the Plantation to
the main Road thence on the road to a division fence thence
along the said fence to the First ditch Thence on the said Di-
-tch to the End thereof and from thence a straight Course to
my Flat swamp line I also give and devise unto my said son
William and to his Heirs for ever the One Third Part of my Flat
swamp Land I also give unto my said son after the Death or
at the Expiration of the Widowhood of his Mother one Negro
Woman named Frank and her Child Ned

Item I give and devise unto my son Jeremiah and his Heirs for Ever
the Land and Plantation whereon he now lives I also give and
devise unto my said son Jeremiah the one Third Part of my Flat
Swamp Land at the upper End during his natural life and
then to my son William and his heirs for Ever.

Item I give and devise unto my son Maximilian and his Heirs
for Ever the Land and Plantation whereon he now lives

I also give and devise unto my said son Morumlin and his Heirs for ever the one third Part of my flat Swamp Land.

Item, I give unto my Daughter Letice, ^{Halsted} one Negro Girl named ^(China)

Item, I give unto my Daughter Martha Weston one Negro
— Named George ^{the} younger

Item, I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth ^{Weston} one Negro named ^(Cesar)

Item, I give unto my Daughter Sarah Sikes one Negro —
— Girl called Violet now in her Infancy —

Item, I leave to my loving wife Elizabeth during her Natural Life the use of Negroes Frank and old George, also her choice of Two Cows and Calves or Yearlings one bed and Furniture one half of all my house and Kitchen Furniture one Horse Two Cows and Lambs.

Item, all the remainder of my Estate of what kind soever I leave to be sold and the money arising from the same to

one half of all my house and Kitchen Furniture one
Horse Two Cows and Lambs.

Item, all the remainder of my Estate of what kind soever I
have to be sold and the money arising from the same to
be Equally divided amongst all my Children - lastly I
do nominate constitute and appoint my sons Robert and
William to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal the seventh Day of Nov^r, in the Year one Thousand
Seven Hundred and Eighty one, Signed Sealed and Acknow-
ledged by the Said Testator to be his Last will and Testament
