in Manner following to Wit — — —

I Give & bequeath to my Son Henry Tucker by Negroes Charles
Sam Lewis Maddy & her Child Dick & Tom Gley this black
Smith Tools also my Wighting Duck one bed & furner & one
small cedar chest which is called my Chest my gunners block
by also I give to my Son Henry Tucker Three hundred pounds
Cash including the Money belonging to him from 922^m
Gristicks Estate & the Shop Rebecca with her sales Rigging &
belonging to her, I give to my Daughter Frances Culbert
four Negroes old Sarah & her Child Pansy Young Sarah &
her Child Moses & one hundred pounds Cash I give to my
Son Travis Tucker the house & Land where now I live with all
the buildings upon it & I give to my Son John Tucker the Land
Thomas that was the Gleebe, I give to my Daughter Sam
Tucker Two hundred pounds Cash & to my Daughter
Rebecca Ely & Tucker one hundred pounds Cash —
I give to my Wife Rebecca Ely Tucker four Negroes old
Nanny Rachel Nancy & Tom & Two hundred pounds
Cash, its my Will that my Brigg Three Brothers be
Sold & the money arising from the sale with what money
I may have otherwise be put to Interest with good security
I mean after the Negroes be paid off my last Debts, and
the Interest of that money with the profits of my Estate
be applied to the bringing up & schooling of my four
youngest Children Rebecca Ely Travis Sam & Eliza Tucker

in Manner following to Wit -

I give & bequeath to my Son Henry Tucker six Negroes, Charles
Samuel Mudge their Child Dick & Tom Gley & his black
Smith Tools also my Wroughty Duck one bed & furnitures & one
small cedar chest which is called my chest my gun barrel & bow
& bag also I give to my Son Henry Tucker three hundred pounds
Cash including the Money belonging to him from 922nd
Gristock Estate & the Slave Rebecca with her sale Rigging &
belongings to her, I give to my Daughter Frances Calvert
four Negroes old Sarah & her Child Pancropy Young Sarah &
her Child Moses & one hundred pounds Cash I give to my
Son Travis Tucker the house & Land where I now live with all
the buildings upon it & I give to my Son John Tucker the Land
thence that was the Gleebe, I give to my Daughter Sam
Tucker two hundred pounds Cash & to my Daughter
Rebecca Ely & Tucker one hundred pounds Cash -
I give to my Wife Rebecca Ely Tucker four Negroes old -
Nanny Rachel Nancy & Tom & two hundred pounds
Cash, it is my Will that my Brigg Three Brothers be
sold & the money arising from the sale with what money
I may have otherwise be put to Interest with good security
I mean after the Negroes be paid off my last Debt, and
the Interest of that money with the profits of my Estate
be applied to the bringing up & schooling of my four
youngest Children Probably Eliza Travis Sam & Eliza Tucker
& to school them as well as their duties & vice versa -
it is my Will that the Slave Hannah be kept to be kind

in the Country & the Money Applied as before to the
Bringing up of them four youngest Children its my
Will & Desire of my Wife keep the household & others
& during her Widowhood that I now live in also the
Land &c that was called the Glebe With the Tithes that
I should not already given away, also the stock but if she
should marry then I would have the Tithes Divided Amongst
her four Children & her Self as also the Household goods to
be Appraised & my Wife to Take them as the Appraisers
if she died & the Money to be Divided Between her Two
Daughters Rebecca Eliza & Jane Tucker & her Self, its my
Will that the Money ordered to be put to Interest to
be Equally Divided between my Two youngest Sons
Frederic & John Tucker When they Come of Age to Receive
its but if my Wife should live a Widow till my
Children Come of Age then I would have them ^{have the money & lands}
paid them as they Come of Age ^{its my Will that if}
my Son Frederic should Die without heir Lawfully begotten
his body then the said house &c to go to my Son John
& to his heirs Lawfully begotten of his body & for want
of such Heirs to my Son Henry Tucker & his Heirs
as before & for want of such Heirs to my Two Daughters
Rebecca Eliza & Jane Tucker to be Equally Divided -
its my Will that if my Son Frederic should Die as above
mentioned that my Son John should have the said &c
then my Son John to pay to my Daughters Rebecca Eliza
& Jane Tucker each one hundred pounds current Money
but if my Two Sons Frederic & John should both die so that

I had not already given away, also the Stock but if the
Should Marry then I would have the Negroes Divided Amongst
her four Children & her Self as also the Household goods to
be Appraised & my Wife to Take them as the Appraisers
if she liked & the Money to be Divided Between her & two
Daughters Rebecca Eliza & Jane Tucker & her Self, its my
Will that the Money ordered to be put to Interest to
be Equally Divided between my two Youngest Sons
Lewis & John Tucker When they come of Age to Receive
its but if my Wife should Live a Widow till my
Children come of Age then I would have their portions
paid them as they come of Age ^{except the Negroes & goods} its my Will that if
my Son Lewis should Die without heir Lawfully begotten
of his body then the Lot I have &c to go to my Son John
& to his heirs Lawfully begotten of his body & for want
of such Heirs to my Son Henry Tucker & his Heirs
as before & for want of such Heirs to my Two Daughters
Rebecca Eliza & Jane Tucker to be Equally Divided -
its my Will that if my Son Lewis should Die as above
mentioned that my Son John should have the Lot I have
then my Son John to pay to my Daughter Rebecca Eliza
& Jane Tucker each one hundred pounds current Money
but if my two Sons Lewis & John should both die so that
my Son Henry Tucker should have the Land &c then
Lewis Tucker

My Son Henry to pay each of my Daughters one hundred
fifty pounds Current Money I mean Francis Calvert & my
Two other Daughters Rebecca & Anne Tucker its my will
I Desire that if either of my Children should Die without
Issue I may be gotten of their bodies then for their
Negroes & Come by me to be Equally Divided amongst
all my Children but as for the Negroes that Come
by my Wife Rebecca to go to her Children to be
Equally Divided there it should like I appoint John
Hitchings Junr Christopher Perkins Dr. C. Lewis &
Henry Tucker to be my Executors of this my Last
Will & Testament Revoking all other Wills made
by me This twentieth day of Sep. Seventeen hundred
Eighty Two
