it hath Pleased God to Bless me with I do give and Bequeath as followeth ~
Item I leave all my Estate of what kind soever after my Just Debts are
paid unto my Loving wife Mary Williamson During her Natural Life
and after her Decease to be Equally Divided Between my Two Daughters
that is to say Fencela Williamson and Lurana Williamson and their
heirs forever and for the True Performing of this my last Will
and Testament I do Nominate Ordain and Appoint my Loving
wife Mary Williamson whole and sole Executrix of this my last Will
and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand &

and after her Decease to be Equally Divided Between my two Daughters
that is to say Fenela Williamson and Lurana Williamson and their
heirs for ever and for the True Performing of this my last Will
and Testament I do Nominate Ordain and Appoint my loving
wife Mary Williamson whole and sole Executrix of this my last Will
and Testament In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
fixt my seal the Eight Day of February One Thousand seven hundred
and Sixty three John Williamson and seal. —
