my Family do make this my Last Will & Testament in the following manner Viz
I Give to my Loving Mother Sarah Freeman the House where she now Lives
with One Acre of Land whereon the House stands & Desire she may be
Quitted there with During her Natural Life
I Give to my Son Samuel one Shilling Sterling
to my Daughter Judith one Shilling Sterling
to my Daughter Sarah one Shilling Sterling
I Give

I Give to my Son John one Shilling Sterling
I Give to my Son Willis one Shilling Sterling
I Give to my Wife Katharine all the Household Goods & other things of what kind soever
Which she was Possessed of at the Time I married her together with the Use of my Plantation
Whereon I live During her Natural Life or Widowhood one Cow one Cattle one Buck
one Bacon one Plate and after the Death or Marriage of my said Wife I Give & Bequeath
my afore mentioned Plantation to my Son Robert and the Heirs of his Body Lawfully
Begotten forever & for want of Such Heirs to my Son Willis & the Heirs of his Body
Lawfully Begotten forever I Give to my Son Robert all my Personal Estate the disposed of
I do Hereby Appoint my Son Robert & my Friend John Goloff Just my Executors of
this my Will

Signed Sealed Published and Declared
to be the last will & Testament of the
Said John Wingate this 2^d Day of
December 1768 in Presence of us
