In the Name of God Amen April the 16th day one thousand
seven hundred and sixty one I John Wright of Norfolk County
being sick and weak in Body, but of perfect Mind and Memory
do make, ordain, constitute and appoint this to be my last Will
and Testament in manner and form as follows viz
Item I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Wright five Shillings
current Money of Virginia in full of his Portion, my Will
and desire is that my said son Thomas should not come in to
have any part of my Estate the five Shillings only before given unto him

I give and bequeath to my son James Wright my Manor
Plantation whereon I now live one hundred Acres of land more
or less to him and his heirs forever; I also give unto my said
son James my Musket, Sword, Bagonet and Catouch Box to him
and his heirs forever. My Will and desire is that if my son
James Wright dies without lawfull heir or Issue of his Body
that then the above mentioned land and plantation shall fall
to my son John Wright and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Courtney Wright the first
Child that my Negro Wench Phillis brings that lives to be two
Years old to her and her heirs forever, my will and desire is if
the first Child ^{dies} before it is two Years old, that my daughter
Courtney shall have the first Child that Phillis brings that
lives to be two Years old, and if my daughter Courtney dies
without heir of her Body, then the aforementioned Negro
Child to fall to my daughter Jane Wright and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to Lydia Ballentine daughter of Ann Ballentine
the second Child that my Negro Wench Phillis brings that lives to be

not my Will and desire is that the said Negro Child falls to my

Item I give and bequeath to my Son John Wright all the rest of
my Estate not before given after my just Debts paid and
Estate settled to him and his heirs forever, and if my Son John
Wright dies without lawfull heir of his Body, my Will and
desire is the Legacy given him shall fall to my Son James

Wright and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Son John Wright all the rest of my Estate not before given after my just Debts paid and Estate settled to him and his heirs forever. and if my Son John Wright dies without lawfull heir of his Body, my Will and desire is the Legacy given him shall fall to my Son James Wright and his heirs forever. my Will and desire is that all my Estate given to my Son John Wright should be sold at publick Sale by my Executor, and the Money thence arising kept by my Executor till my sons are of Age to receive it is

I also constitute and appoint George Wright Burgess to be my
Executor of this my last Will and Testament, and I do hereby
disallow revoke, and disannul all and every other former Wills
Legacies and Bequeaths by me before made ratifying & confirm-
ing this to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I
