in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing

Writing but at the general Refunction I shall receive the same again by the mighty power
 of God as touching such worldly Estate whereunto it hath pleased God to bless me with
 in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form

Imprimus I give and bequeath unto my Darling beloved Wife Sarah Brown my
 Plantations whereon I now live to her holes and proper Use Untill my son William Brown
 shall come to Age of Twenty One years but if my wife should marry before my death
 comes to age then to be put to her thirds by the Executors. Untill my son William Brown
 comes to age and if it should please God to take my son William Brown he leaving one
 Heir lawfully begotten of his body then my will and Desire that my Daughter Lydia
 Brown should Injoy my land to her and Heirs lawfully begotten of her body forever
 I likewise constitute make and Ordain my Brother Thomas Brown my Sole & sole Executor
 of this my last will and Testament all and Singular my hands & I do hereby disallow
 revoke and Disannul all and every other former Testaments wills & Legacies Requests
 and bequest by me any ways before this Time made conforming this & no other
 to my last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and Seal the day and year Above written
