constitute and appoint this to be my Last Will & Testament —
First and principally I Give and recommend my soul into the
Hand of Almighty God That gave it me Hoping to be saved thro
his Mercy and the merits of the Death and Passion of our
Blessed Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and my Body I commend
to the Earth to be Decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors
not in the least Doubting But at the General Resurrection I Shall
Receive the same again by the mighty Power of God to Inherit
Everlasting life

and for the Worldly Estate Wherewith it hath pleased God to bless
me I Give dispose and Devise of the same in the following
manner and form that is to say

Imprimis I make ordain constitute and appoint my Dearly
Beloved father Joseph Creekmur my whole and sole Executor of
this my last Will and Testament

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved father Joseph Creekmur a
Negro fellow Name Ned to him and his Heirs for ever

Item I Give and Bequeath to my woman after Woodard One Young kifer
big with calf she is brinded and white to her and her Heirs for ever

Item I Give and Bequeath all the Rest of my cattle and hogs to my beloved
Father Joseph Creekmur to him and his Heirs for ever

And I do hereby Revoke and Disannull all former Wills and Testaments
made by me heretofore Ratifying and Confirming this and no other
to be my last will and Testament
