Mill Likewise, my Gun and Sword and all my Outtriments for the
Militia.

Item Lastly It is my desire that my Beloved wife Elizabeth Williamson
and my Eldest Son John Williamson shall be my whole and Sole Executors
of this my last Will & Testament, Renouncing all other Wills or
Wills formerly made by me and declare this to be my last Will and
Testament Whereunto I set my Hand and Give my Seal this 5th day of
