Item I give to my said wife one hundred and fifty pounds cash to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give to my Nephew Jonathan Langley (the son of my Brother James Langley) the Land I bought of Mr. Charles Boush near Norfolk, to the said Jonathan Langley and

Brother James Langley the Land Bought of Mr. Char-
Boush near Norfolk, to the said Jonathan Langley and
his Heirs forever.

Item I give to my Niece Mary Godfrey the sum of fifty Pounds to be
put on Interest till she arrives to Lawfull age or marries but in
case of her death before Lawfull age or marriage then I give -
the said principal and Interest to my Nephew William
Langley the son of my Brother James Langley to him
and his Heirs forever.

Item I give to my loving Wife Sarah Langley two Cows & Calves
her own choice to her and her Heirs forever.

Item all the rest of my Estate not already mentioned I leave to
be sold and the money arising from such sale to discharge
my Just debts, and the Ballance I give to my Loving Wife
Sarah Langley and her Heirs forever.

Item I give to my said Loving wife all my Hogs Corn -
meat and Loxs of Every kind to her and her Heirs forever.

Now I give to my loving Nephew William Langley my silver shoe
Buckle to him and his Heirs forever.

Now I give to my loving Nephew Joseph Langley my silver shoe
Buckle to him and his Heirs forever.

Lastly I leave my Wife Sarah Langley and Arthur Boush
Executors of this my last Will and Testament in Testa-
mony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
