plantation I now dwell on my Will and desire is that my Wife Sarah White
Should have the one half of the said plantation & half Orchard & half the house
knowing her Widow hood likewise I give to my son Peter White one Desk one
large Copper Kettle Ten hogs Twenty One Shotes which is in his own mark
Two Stock of Deer Eight head of Cattle Small po. Sticks and one Shutein Gun
to him and his heirs for ever my Will is that my son Peter White should
have the movable Estate as I have given him to do as he pleases with
and for him to live with his Mother as usual till he comes to age.

Twenty. I Give to my Wife Sarah White the Use of one negro Wench & Child of Increase of the said Wench This Child Called Tripson And when her Widow hood my Will is that if my Wife Should marry for the wench & Child of Increase of the said Wench to fall to my son Frederick White to him and his heirs for ever if in Case my Wife or Sarah White Should not marry at her death for the said Negroes to fall to my son Frederick White as aforesaid mentioned

Item. I Give to my Wife Sarah White Two horses Called by Name Fidler & Guinea one bed and Furniture One large Iron Cook Three Cows & Calves one Case of Bottles One Cane Chair One Small Trunk Ten Sows and Pigs Ten Sheep all the Flax as grows on the Plantation fifty Barrells Corn all the Wheat that is grows on the Plantation all the Coppers Wear as I own all the Lanthorn Wear and the Pewter and all the Glass Wear: Six Stocks of Bees one pt. Smother Irons One Table and

I Give to my Son Patrick White all the Land as I own at the Indian Creek in North Carolina containing Two hundred Acres more or less also One Negro Man Called Shippard to him and his heirs for ever also one Scatter Gun One Coffee mill One Case of Bottles my desire is that my said negro Called Shippard Should be hired out yearly & the money to Support the Child with as he needeth also one Bed and Furniture and 1 Small Iron Pot

Item. I Give to my Son James ^{White} One Water Mill and all the appurtenances that belongs to her and One Negro Wench Called Rachel
