for the same, Do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament
in the following manner & Form. Principally & first of all I do
Recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who giveth
and my Body to the Earth to be lawfully buried at the discretion
of my Executrix hereafter named, & as touching all such Estate as
it hath pleased God to bestow upon me in this life, I do give & bestow
thereof in the following manner & form. — Viz^t. First my will & desire
is that all my Just & Lawful Debts & Funeral Expences be paid & discharged.

Item I do give unto my son William Wright my Gun

Item My will & desire is that there may be raised out of my Estate
Twenty & One Shillings & Sixpence for each of my two Sons, Viz^t,
Kelly, & John Willis Wright to buy each of them a Gun & to give
to them as soon as they come to the age of one & twenty years.

Item All the Rest & Residue of my Estate of what Kind & Nature soever I
do give & bequeath by Will & bequest hereof unto my Wife Jane Wright,
for & during her Widowhood, And afterward, to be equally divided
amongst all my Children (her Lawfull Dowry excepted).

Furthermore I do Nominate, Constitute & Appoint my Loving wife
Above, whole & Sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testament.
In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the Day &
Date first above Written.
