I farther give my Wife the crop of Corn now in my field.
Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Allan Powell all
my wearing Apparel. & Lastly I nominate & appoint
my loving Wife Mary Powell my Executrix and my

John Powell my Executor of this my last Will and Tes-
tament, Revoking & Disannulling all former Wills by me
made In Testimony whereof I have sett my Hand & Seal
this Eighteenth Day of March in the Year of our Lord God
One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Seven.
