

Daniel Cuthrell March Court 1782 proved & as Order
Book

In the name of God Amen I Lethian Bulport of Nor-
folk County being weak of Body but of Perfect mind and Me-
mory thanks be to God for it do make and declare this my
last will and Testament that is to say Principally and
first of all I recommend my soul into the hands of God
that gave it and as for my body I recommend to Earth to
be buried in Christian like and decent Manner at the Dis-
cretion of my Executors nothing doubting but I shall receive the same
Against the general resurrection by the mighty Power of God and
as touching such Worldly Estate wherewith it hath ^{been} Pleased God

to bless me within this life I give, devise, and dispose in manner and form as followeth.

Item I give and bequeath unto Thomas Creekmore forty pounds for Shillings that I paid W. James Webb ^{senr} for the right of land and also one red cow called Blossom & one yearling and likewise one pewter Dish four pewter Plates, 2 Pewter Basins, and six pound of Feathers out of my Bed to him and his heirs forever and also one Table.

Item I give and bequeath unto my sister anna Pilgot my part of the Negroes as they have never been divided and the remainder of my Bed and furniture and one one cow and calf called Gentle and one Sinner Wheel and one chest five Earthen Plates and one dish and two Barrows and one loom & flay and furs and all my wearing Apparel, except my red cloak that I give to my sister Lydia to her and her heirs forever.

I likewise appoint Thomas Creekmore to be my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament ratifying & confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament.

Witness the 19. 1779

I therefore appoint Thomas Creekmour to be my whole and
sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament ratifying &
confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament
November the 19. 1779
