I give to my Daughter Ann Southerland and her Heirs forever
Only my Negro Fellow Slavey Samson that I bought of M^r.
Malbon I give him his freedom only first paying to my Daughter
Ann Southerland the Ballance due of his Account to me as will
be found by my Brother William Conner Executor — of this my
last Will and Testament Witness my Hand and Seal this Tenth
Day of November 1763. —
