household and Kitchen Furniture, also my silver Spoon
and all the remainder of my estate be it of what na-
ture or kind so ever, the same I give unto my said
sister Martha and her heirs for ever.

Lastly, I do hereby appoint and nominate Mr. Charles
Sayer Boush my whole and sole executor, to this my
last Will and Testament, revoking all others heretofore
made, in testimony whereof I have set my Hand
and affixed my Seal this twenty sixth day of August
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
ninety.

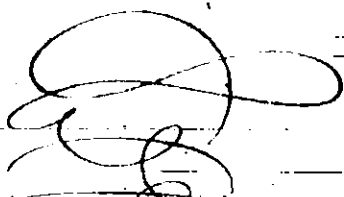
