ever And my House to my Son William Tucker and I give to my
William Tucker a horse

Item I give to my Daughter Abbe Tucker a Road Cow and I give to
her a Leathr guler Belt

Item I give to my Daughter Mary Cherry one Road Cow and a horse
yearling

Item I give to my wife Judith Tucker one Road Cow and the
House my plot of my Estate that is not all my wife's & ways
I give to my wife Judith Tucker during her life

And I give my wife Judith Tucker to be Equally divided
between my Son William Tucker and my Daughter Mary Cherry
and Abbe Tucker. and I make for it Tucker and appoint my
Son William Tucker to be my sole and sole Executor of this
my last will and testament to order according to my will
to be fulfilled in every Respect as I have bequeathed
in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Seal this March the 28 Day 1758
