vided between my Daughter Mary Deans and Liddy
Joyce & Nancy Black and also Two hogs fatten to my
Daughter Mary Deans and Six Barrel of Corn Eight
Hogs fatten to my Daughter Liddy Joyce and one hund-
weight of Pork to Nancy Black one small sow with pig
to Mary Deans two year Old Barron Shoats to Nancy
Black and also one sow and seven pigs and one shoat

Blacks and also one cow and seven Pigs and one Shoat
To my Daughter Liddy Joye and my man and cart
and wheels and Saddle and Bridle and a Boat to move ^{to} ^{pleases} ^{where} ^{she} ^{likes}
The said to my Daughter Mary Deans

And a hand Mill and one Bed, and also Two Beds To
My Daughter Liddy Joye

I give and Bequeath to name Blacks two Plates and
one dish and all the rest of my Tuten to be Equally Divided
between my Two Daughters Mary Deans and Liddy Joye

also Two Iron pots to my Daughter Liddy Joye and one
small Iron Pot to my Daughter Mary Deans and Tying
I am also one Sea Cattle to my Daughter Liddy Joye and

and Lidday Joyce and Mary Dears
Dears all a Parcel Toe clothe my Daughter Lidday Joyce
a thred and Mary Dears One also a pair Shus to Nancy
Black and the rest of my feather to be Divided Between
Mary Dears and Lidday Joyce and my rum and
Brandy and I do Ordain William Bailey and
Jesse Dears my whole and sole Executors of
this my last will and Testament In Witness
