I give to Mary Carter the Daughter of Mary Avery one Bed
one Rug one Blanket and one pair sheets.

I give to my Cousin Nathaniel Tatem sent my Negro Man
Gammy and half of Stock to him and his Heirs forever. I further
give to Nathaniel Tatem sent all the Remainder part of my
Estate not before given, and I do appoint Nathaniel Tatem sent
my sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament revoking &
making void all former Will and Testaments by me made. In
Witness hereunto I have set my Hand and Seal this 29 day of April
1765.
