tioned and my temporal Estate I dispose of as follows viz (

Item I give unto bequeath unto my Daughter Anne Nash during her
natural life the Bed & furniture whereon I lie and at her
decease to my grandson Charles Nash and his Heirs also a flat
Iron to my said Daughter —

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Martha Portlock the
Bed & furniture that stands in the great Room also one flat
Iron half dozen chairs one Tea Kettle, one large Iron Pott and
one small do. one Heifer with half one Riding Mare called Bon-
ny and three small hogs to her and her Heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Charles Portlock one brown
Heifer and red Stear to him and his Heirs forever —

Item I also give unto my Daughter Martha Two Dishes and
Pewter Plates Six Tea Spoons and Six Table Lin. to her
her Heirs.

And lastly for the true performance hereof I do appoint
my Brother in Law Thomas Edwards Executor to this
my last Will and Testament revoking all former Wills
by me made and ratifying and confirming this only in tes-
timony whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and fixed
my Seal this Seventeenth Day of November in the year
of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred & Seventy-
five.
