and Testament, in manner and form following Voz. I give and bequeath
my Landed Estate at Sowels Point, consisting of Two Hundred and
fifty Acres, together with the Stock of Cattle, Horses, Sheep, Hogs,
wearing Apparel, Riding & Chair & Harness, Household & Kitchen
Furniture, and Plate, left and bequeathd my by my late Mother Ann
Sweny and Husband, / also Five Silver Table and Six Tea Spoons,
and one Pair of Tea Tongs, left with me in Power by Frances
Brown, in Case they are not returned - redeemed - to my three
Daughters Ann, Elizabeth, and Martha Willoughby, and their
Heirs forever, as Tenants in common; And it is also my Will -
that the above mentioned Estate Stock &c. shall be sold when
my youngest Daughter arrives at the Age of Twenty One Years,
and the proceeds divided amongst my said Daughters Ann, Eli-
zabeth, and Martha, equally Share and Share alike, but in
case either of my said Daughters ~~should~~ do not live untill
the Youngest reach the Age of Twenty One Years aforesaid
the Survivors shall be intitled to and receive her or their Shares

the youngest reach the Age of Twenty one years aforesaid
the Survivors shall be entitled to and receive her or their Shares,
unless the Deceased Daughter or Daughters aforesaid should leave
an Heir or Heirs of her or their own Body or Bodies, but in case
the youngest should die before she arrives to the Age of Twenty

do hereby Revoke, disannull, and make void all former and other
Will ^{and} Wills by me at any Time heretofore made. In Witness

eighth Day of February in the Year of our Lord one Thou-
=sand Seven Hundred and Seventy Eight.
