

In the name of God Amen. I Mary Creedle of Elizabeth Parish in the County of Norfolk being sick and weak but in Perfect sense and memory do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following.

I give and bequeath unto my son Francis Creedle his heirs or assigns the land I bought of Richard Ballance being about fifty eight acres more or less. And if it should happen that my said son die before he arrives to the age of 21 years or without lawful issue then I give the said land to my daughter Sarah Creedle her heirs or assigns. And if it should happen that my said daughter Sarah die before marriage, or before she arrives to the age of twenty one years then I give the said land to Anne Ballance her heirs or assigns.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Ann Ballance a good bed and furniture. I desire likewise that my wearing Apparel may be equally divided between my two daughters, And likewise that Anne may have the Wool & flax to Cloath her and the Children.

I sell & all the rest that belong to me may be sold & the money arising therefrom be applied towards discharging my just debts. And what remains to be equally divided among my three Children.

And if either my son, or daughter Sarah should die before they come to the age of twenty one & the part so given to be equally divided between the other two. And lastly I do appoint my brother Daniel Macfarson to be Executor of this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and affixed my Seal this nineteenth Day September 1755.
