4^{thly} I give & bequeath unto my son John Part Three Yards of home spun Cloth

5^{thly} I give & bequeath unto my son John Richard Eastwood one Coat

6^{thly} I give and Bequeath the Remaing part of my Estate of Every kind whatsoever

which I have not already given to my Daughter Lydia Part

lastly I Appoint my Brother Richard Powell to be my Executor

2nd I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Deans one cotton gown & Coat

3rd I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Pally Eastwood one cotton gown & Coat

4th I give & bequeath unto my Son John Tart Three yards of home spun Black

6th I give and Bequeath the Remaining part of my Estate of Every kind whatsoever which I have not already given to my Daughter Liza Tart

lastly I appoint my Brother Richard Powell Junr to be my Executor to this my last Will & Testament in Witness whereon I have hereunto set my Hand and Affixed my Seal this the Twenty second Day of June in the Year of Lord One thousand seven Hundred & Seventy Seven
