Executors of this my last will & Testament thereby
revoking & Disannulling all wills & Testaments by me
heretofore made and declaring this to be my last will
& Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto
Set my hand and affixed my Seal at Norfolk
this Twentieth sixth day of February Anno Dom:
one thousand seven hundred & sixty two.
