Item I Give to my Daughter Elizabeth Godfrey my Negro Woman Bridget and all her Increase the said Negro before given by ^{me} Died of Gift I Further Give to my Daughter Elizabeth my Negro Man called Jack Connor after the death of my Wife or her Widowhood the said Negro to be at the Disposal of my said Daug^r Elizabeth I further Give to my said Daughter Elizabeth Godfrey One Feather Bed and Furniture being in full of her Portion of my Estate

Item I Give to my Son Matthew Godfrey my Plantation of Land where I now Live on being about five Hundred Acres of Land to him my said Son and the Heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten But if my said Son Matthew Godfrey Dies Without

Oval table One Bed in the Hall Chamber and Furniture and
One Dark looking Glass and Jewels One Horse Bitch One pair
of Iron Sags One piece being in full of his portion of my Estate
I Give to my Daughter Dinah Belgrave One piece to the having
received her portion of my Estate

Part of my Estate not before Given And Appoint my Wife
Dinah Godfrey and my Son Matthew Godfrey to be my
Whole and Sole Executors and Executors to see this my Last
Will and Testament performed In Witness hereunto I have
set my Hand and this 3rd day of April 1754
